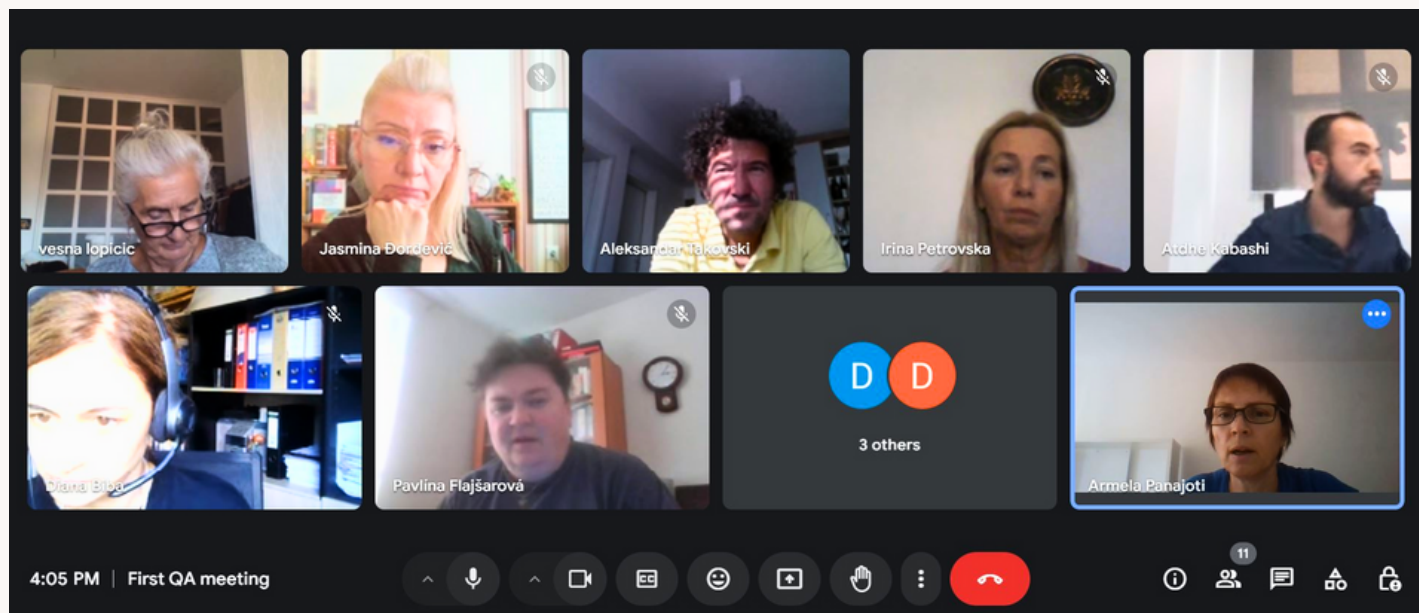
Highlights from Spain!

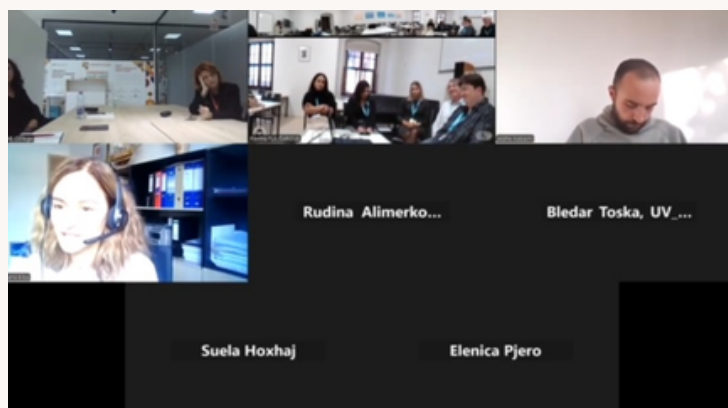
Additionally, we discussed the implementation of our Quality Assurance Strategy (QAS) for the first year of the project. Let's keep up the great work!
